LEGAL BASIS

The processing of personal data provided and/or inferred by browsing the Site is treated on the basis of consent, with the use of the visitors and users explicitly endorse this privacy policy, and consent to the processing of their personal data in relation to the methods and purposes described below.

However, it is always possible to ask the Owner to clarify the concrete legal basis of each treatment and in particular to specify whether the treatment is based on the law, provided for in a contract or necessary to conclude a contract.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures for the operation of this site acquire, during the course of their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers and terminals used by the users, the addresses in URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters related to the operating system, and to the user's computer environment.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed for the purpose of:

- to obtain statistical information on the use of the services (most visited pages, number of visitors per time slot, or daily, geographical areas of origin, etc.);

- check the correct functioning of the services offered;
- respond to your request for contact (commercial request, information, etc..) for which you will receive specific consent required;

Browsing data are not retained for more than seven days and are deleted immediately after they have been deleted.

aggregation (except for any need to ascertain crimes by the Judicial Authority).

Data communicated by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of messages to the contact addresses of the Owner, as well as the compilation and the forwarding of the forms present on the Owner's site, involve the acquisition of the sender's contact data, necessary to respond, as well as all personal data included in communications.

Specific information will be published on the pages of the Owner's site prepared for the provision of certain services.

Cookies and other tracking systems

Cookies are not used for user profiling, nor are other tracking methods used.

Instead, session cookies are used (not persistent) in a strictly limited way to what is necessary for the safe and efficient navigation of the sites. The storage of session cookies in terminals or browsers is under the control of the user, where on the servers, at the end of the HTTP sessions, information relating to cookies remains recorded in the logs of the services, with storage times not exceeding seven days as other data of navigation.

DATA RECIPIENTS

The following are the recipients of the data collected following the consultation of the above listed sites Owner, pursuant to Article 28 of the Regulation, as data processors:

Franco Pupillo as provider of development and maintenance services of the website;

Eticoweb as provider of the technological platform on which the site resides.

The personal data collected are also processed by the staff of the Owner, who act on the basis of specific instructions provided with regard to the purposes and methods of the processing itself.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTIES

The interested parties have the right to obtain from the Data Controller, in the cases provided for, access to personal data and the correction or the

cancellation of the same or the limitation of the treatment that concerns them or to oppose the treatment (art. 15 and following of the Regulations).

For the processing activities for which the legal basis is the consent given by you, you have the right of revocation of the same at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent given before the revocation.

RIGHT OF COMPLAINT

The interested parties who believe that the processing of personal data referred to them through this site is carried out in violation of the provisions of the Regulations have the right to lodge a complaint to the Owner, as provided for by art. 77 of the Regulation itself, or to take appropriate legal action (art. 79 of the Regulation).

Cookie PolicyThe purpose of this "Cookie Policy" is to provide, in line with the principle of transparency which regulates the relationship with our customers, information on the types, purposes and ways of use/management of cookies sent during their navigation on the website managed by Lumis S.r.l.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text strings that are sent from a website to your browser used by the user for navigation, stored on the device (e.g. Computer, Tablet, smartphone, etc.) and retransmitted to the same site the next time the user visits. Usually a cookie presents as a string containing at least the name of the internet site from which the cookie is taken originates, the "duration" of the cookie, and a value, which is usually a unique number generated in such a way as to be random. On the basis of the subject in charge of the management of the cookies sent by a website is distinguished two types of cookies:

- of "**first party**" when they are managed directly by the owner and/or publisher of the website (Lumis S.r.l.) - of "**third party**" when cookies are managed by subjects unrelated to the website visited by the user.

First party cookies Cookies play an important role in web browsing. We use cookies to improve and facilitate the user experience by storing, for example, some information about the browser used by the latter (e.g. language, country, shopping cart, etc.) and avoiding having to re-enter them on subsequent visits to the site. Lumis S.r.l. does not use cookies from before starts in order to track the online behavior of the users of the websites managed for its own purposes of marketing. Cookies do not allow us to recognize individual users who visit our websites, but only the browser used for browsing, unless they have done access to your account.

What cookies do we use?

Below is a description of the types of first-party cookies sent by the site:

- **Technical cookies**

Technical cookies are essential for the proper functioning of some sections of the site and are used to allow users the normal navigation and the possibility to use the services available on our Web Sites, without which could not function properly. We also use technical cookies to keep track, in accordance with the regulations in force (ref. Provision "Identification of the modalities simplified for the information and acquisition of consent for the use of cookies" of 8 May 2014) of the consent given by users to receive third party profiling and analytics cookies. Our website uses or may use the following categories of technical cookies, broken down according to the classification proposed in Opinion 04/2012 on the exemption from consent for the use of cookies issued by the Working Group ex art. 29 in the community (available here: http://ec.europa.eu/justice/data-protection/article-29/documentation/opinionrecommendation/files/2012/wp194_it.pdf#h2-8): -Permanent cookies that allow, for example, to:

- Manage and remember the items added to the shopping cart in the online shop - Allow users to access a user area without having to log in continuously- Remember any actions users (e.g., completing a form) when you return to the previous of a session
- Session cookies that are sent to the user's device/browser to respond to needs technical-functional (e.g. transmission of session identifiers necessary for authentication to restricted areas) but are not permanently stored on the computer of the users and deleted at the end of the "session" by simply closing the browser.

Third party cookies

While browsing our websites, it is possible that certain cookies may be sent to you that do not belong to our domains (so called "Third Party Cookies") when, for example, users visit a page that includes content from a third party website. Some Third Parties may send, through the our site, cookies that allow us to understand the habits and preferences expressed by users during navigation, in order to allow them to adapt the ads advertising shown on our websites. Some types of cookies, managed by Third Parties, allow us to also to obtain aggregated statistical information on the visits received and the habits of navigation, in order to improve the usability and performance of our sites. For greater clarity, Lumis S.r.l.,

below is a list of the types of Third Party Cookies that could send cookies while browsing our sites and their descriptions and pages/websites where is possible to consult the information regarding the use of these cookies and deny your consent to the sending of the cookies themselves.

What Third Party cookies do we use?

The website may send Third Party cookies of the following types:

- **Cookies Analytics**

These cookies are used by Lumis S.r.l. to collect and analyze aggregate information and anonymous for statistical analysis on access and visits in order to improve the performance and design of the our website. They may also be used to limit the frequency with which it is proposed an advertisement and show, therefore, advertising based on the interest of users and as an aid for measure the effectiveness of a campaign.

- **Profiling Cookies**

They allow us to obtain information about users' navigation on our websites (for example, the products and/or services most viewed) and to recognize those who return to visit our website, allowing you to build anonymous profiles aimed at making the advertisements more engaging and targeted. No personal information, enabling the identification of the individual user and the resulting association with the advertising profile created is shared with Third Parties. Below is a list of Third Parties that may send Analytics and/or profiling cookies while browsing on our sites and related links to privacy policies and forms for the withdrawal of consent to their receipt:

Any revocation, however, will not remove the advertising from the web pages that are visited by the users, but will make such advertisements not based on your interests.

How we obtain consent to receive cookies

In line with the provisions of current legislation, for the sending of profiling and analytics cookies of third party, during the first visit of users to our sites is required prior consent, which can be expressed in the following ways:- by clicking on any

link within the page- by clicking on the "Ok" key or on the "X" key of the banner containing the brief information through this Cookie policy

How to change your browser preferences

Consent to the receipt of cookies can also be expressed through specific configurations of the browser by users. Most browsers allow you to set up rules to manage the cookies sent by only a few or all of the sites, which gives users more precise control of the privacy and to deny the possibility of receiving the cookies themselves. Below are the indications to manage cookies through the settings of the main browsers:

However, Lumis S.r.l. would like to remind you that the restriction on the ability of websites to send cookies may worsen the users' global browsing experience. Methods of processing Personal data acquired, are processed through the use of automated tools and / or manually and only for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data were collected.

Lumis S.r.l. observes, however, the regulations in force in order to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

Rights of the interested parties

The subjects to whom the data refer have the right, in accordance with art. 7 D.Lgs 196/2003, to obtain in any time, the confirmation of the existence or not of their personal data, to know the content and origin, verify its accuracy or request its integration or updating or rectification. At according to the same article you have the right to request the cancellation, transformation into a new form anonymous or the blocking of data processed in violation of the law, to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, to the their treatment.
